



# CONDITIONS OF ENTRY



It is a condition of entry to the: **Vietnamese Tet 2020** venue (Venue) that patrons agree:

1. To be included in photographs and videotapes as members of a crowd within the festival context, later be posted on the Community media, reports and acquittals.
2. not to (i) wear or otherwise display commercial, political, religious or offensive signage, flags or logos (including anything related to the Communist Vietnam) or engage in ambush marketing generally, or (ii) sell or distribute any goods or services or any other matter or thing, or (iii) collect money or orders from other patrons for goods or services without the prior written consent of the Vietnamese Community in Australia / Western Australia Chapter Incorporated (VCAWA) or (iv) distribute political, religious, advertising or promotional material, in each case without the prior written consent of the VCAWA;
3. that no alcohol, glass, cans, firearms, knives, syringe needles, weapons, sharp items, fireworks or other items deemed or considered dangerous may be brought into the Venue;
4. that entry to the Venue is only permitted to patrons who agree to be scanned and searched (including their bags, clothes or other possessions) on entry and while in the Venue if needs arise.
5. that they enter the Venue at their own risk and agree to indemnify the VCAWA, its Management Committee, employees, agents and contractors against liability in respect of all claims, costs and expenses and for all loss, damage, injury and death to persons or property caused by the patron in connection with their attendance at the event.
6. that smoking is prohibited in all areas of the Venue.
7. without prejudice to any other rights which the VCAWA may have, that if the patron contravenes any of these terms and conditions they may:
  - (a) be refused entry to the Venue;
  - (b) be ejected from the Venue by an authorised event official;
  - (c) have their ticket confiscated and/or cancelled without refund or recompense;
- (d) have legal action taken against them in connection with such matters. Effective for 31.1.2020 and 01.2.2020
